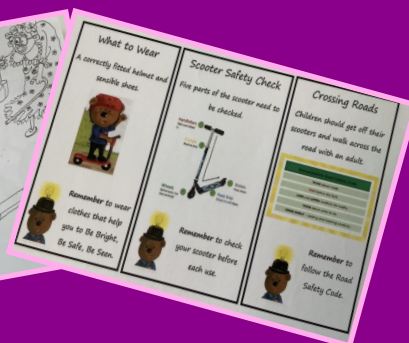
Cherry Class
