# New Intake September 2022

## New Reception Transition Day Plans

We wanted to confirm our arrangements for Reception transition in July. Children will be coming into school on **Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> July 2022 from 9.15am - 11.15am.** 

For the first hour (9.15 - 10.15) we invite parents/carers to stay with their child and their new teachers. This is a chance to explore the provision together and ask the teaching staff any questions you may have. From 10.15 until 11.15 we would ask that you leave your child in the class with the teaching staff and spend some time in the hall with Mr How who will talk with you about the school, how the day works, uniform and any other information you need to be aware of. This will give teaching staff a chance to begin getting to know your child. There is only one transition date and no stay and play on the 8<sup>th</sup> July. This was a previous date that was accidentally printed. We will be visiting Nursery settings in July to gain a greater understanding of your child and spend some time getting to know their likes and dislikes. We will then arrange a home visit with parents/carers for the week beginning 5<sup>th</sup> September where you will be able to share 1:1 information about your child with the class teacher and they will have a chance to get to know your child in their most comfortable place.

# New Nursery Transition Day Plans
