Cherry Class

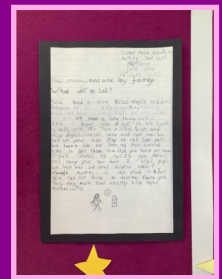
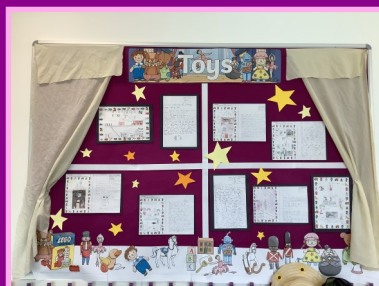
