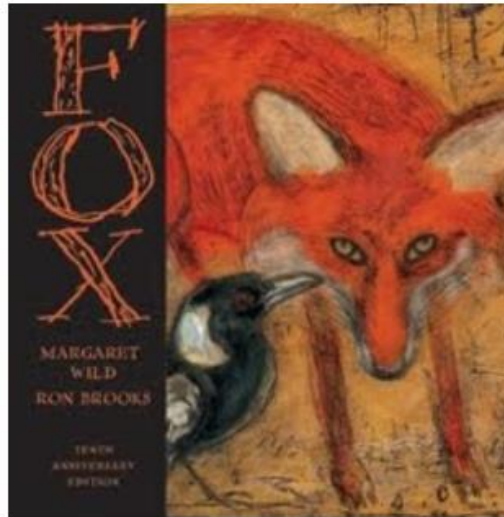


Year 3 – Autumn 2 Homework
