Year 5 – Summer 1 Learning Overview

Geography: Our key focus is 'Would you like to live in the desert?'. We will begin by studying what a hot desert biome is and where deserts are located. We will also study what physical features are found in deserts, how people can use deserts, any threats to deserts and finally answering or unit's question on whether we would like to live in a desert.

Science: Our key focus is 'Unbalanced forces'. During these lessons we will learning about gravity, air resistance and water resistance and friction. We will finish the unit by studying levers, pulleys and gears.

Writing: Our focus book is 'The Lost Book of Adventure'. We will be using this book for two different writing outcomes. The first will be a survival narrative and the second will be a survival guide which will go into Summer 2. We will be continuing to focus on the grammar skills we have been learning about all year and applying these independently in our writing.

PE: Our key focus is rounders and cricket. In rounders, we will learn the rules of the game and how to throw accurately. In cricket, we will learn to also throw a ball with accuracy, work in a pair to score runs and perfect an overarm bowl.

Maths: This half term our focus will be on shape, position and direct and more decimals. In shape, we will continue to apply our knowledge of length and angles to polygons and 3D shapes. In position and direction, we will study coordinates and translation as well as lines of symmetry. In decimals, we will end the half term by adding and subtracting decimals with the same and different decimal places as well as finding efficient strategies to help us.
